Matters Arising	Defibrillator. KdLM advised that the defibrillator has still not been installed. He understood that the delay was because Maylands Nursery were unable to agree a mutually acceptable installation date and that AT would progress the matter on his return from holiday next week.	AT
Environment Department	There were no requests for the Constables to view any plans that were not already available.	
Bornement	The Douzaine approved an application for a Bornement in respect of work to a wall at Rue des Issues. Minor Works – Planning Permission. MT suggested that minor building works involving roadside walls should be devolved to the parishes. The Douzaine agreed that this would be something they would be happy to take responsibility for and KF/MM will take the suggestion forward to the next meeting of the GDC or Douzaine Liaison Group. Guernsey Douzaine Council (GDC)	KF reported on the most recent meeting held on 11 th July 2016. Kerbside collections of Recyclable Waste. Most parishes expressed the view that kerbside collections of recyclable waste would be discontinued unless the States of Guernsey Trading Assets continued to provide the funding. Nuisance Parking. Parking of abandoned cars and cars ‘for sale’ in many locations around the island is causing concern. The GDC Chair will discuss this matter with the Guernsey Liaison Group at the next meeting. Hedge and Stream Inspections. It is generally agreed that the arrangements introduced in September 2015 are working well. Japanese Knotweed. This invasive weed is causing concern in most parishes and it is hoped that the States will introduce guidance as to who is responsible for dealing with the problem. Given the level of concern the Chairman will ask the States for an update on progress. Litter. The suggestion that School Children should receive input within the Personal, Social and Health Education part of the curriculum will be made to the President of Education, Sport and Culture.
