The Rector and Churchwardens of the Parish of St Saviour invite the Ratepayers and Electors thereof to meet in the Herm & Jethou Rooms at **St Saviour's Community Centre**, on **Monday 24th April 2017 at 7.00pm** to transact the following business:

1. To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 25th April 2016.
2. To pass the Trésor Account before the Very Reverend Dean of Guernsey or his delegate.
3. To pass the Church Wardens' Parish Accounts, which have been audited.
4. To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amounts to be levied by means of Owner's Rate in 2017 (in accordance with estimates where appropriate).

*Repairs involve re-plastering the interior walls of the south chapel and chancel. The cost is £37,729 and it is proposed that this sum is found by raising £13,000 from owners' rates, £13,000 from the Parish Reserve Fund (see item 7 of the Constables' notice below) and the remaining £11,729 from the Churchwardens Account (unspent balance).

5. To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the above sums by means of Owners Rates.
6. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Constables and Douzaine may deem advisable.

1. To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 25th April 2016.
2. To approve the Constables' Accounts for 2016, copies of which can be inspected at the Constables' Office on Tuesdays between 2.30pm and 6.30pm and Thursdays between 9.00am and 11.00am.
3. To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amounts, for secular needs, to be levied by means of Owners' Rates in 2017;

4. To decide whether they are in favour of voting £139,222 to be levied for 2017 by means of Refuse Rate for the collection of household refuse;
5. To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the above sums by means of Owners and Refuse Rates;
6. To decide that the Owners and Refuse Rates shall be levied applying the relative factors which are available from the Constables' Office between 2.30pm and 6.30pm on Tuesdays and 9.00am and 11.00am on Thursdays.
7. To decide whether they are in favour of authorising the Constables to draw from the Reserve Fund held in pursuant to the Parochial Taxation (Reserve Funds) (Guernsey) Law 1997 the sum of £13,000 to pay for extraordinary works to be carried out at the Parish Church (re-plastering the interior walls of the south chapel and chancel – see * above in Rector and Churchwardens Notice).
8. To authorise the Constables to include in the application to the Royal Court to be made pursuant to 5 above, the proposed withdrawal from the Reserve Fund for the above purpose.
9. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Constables and Douzaine may deem advisable.
