Minutes of Meeting held on 19th February 2024	The minutes were agreed and signed by the Constable.	
Matters Arising	<p>Douzenier Election PC reported that no nominations were received for the vacant role of Douzenier. It was agreed that if any serious interest was shown in the post we would advertise the post under normal procedures.</p> <p>Green Lanes – JR/PC It was noted that a Parishioner had contacted JR regarding cyclist using the green lanes and causing damage to the extent that the lanes were extremely muddy and becoming unsuitable for pedestrians. There were signs up stating for pedestrians only but no heed was being taken of them. Having taken advice it was noted that it was not possible to restrict the green lanes to pedestrians only and that they lanes were available for all including cyclist and horses although pedestrians did have right of way. It was agreed that SW would take the matter to the Parish Working Group for further ideas but that the Pedestrian signs would be left in place for the time being. MK to write a letter to confirm the action taken.</p> <p>Floral St Saviours - JR It was noted that with the thankful help of the Prison Services the Floral St Saviours Group had created the much-appreciated Project Mindset tranquillity garden in the grounds of the Community Centre. The Floral Group had acknowledged with thanks the additional funding part of which would be used to erect a plaque on one of the entrances to the Community Centre. The Floral Group had asked for suggestions regarding the entrance to the Centre and KF produced a plan of what could be done to the main entrance to make it more welcoming.</p>	SW MK
Parish Rates - PC	The Administration Remede was agreed	
Data Protection - SW	SW advised that no further progress had been made with data protection.	

Planning - JR	It was noted that the Planning Application submitted by The Driftwood Hotel for 7 units of accommodation would require the review by the Douzaine. JG advised that he had reviewed the plans online and advised that the development would be at the rear of the hotel facing inland and would not require additional green space. After discussion and balancing the need for affordable housing against hotel beds those present had no objection to the new units.	
Any other business	<p>Scrutiny Management Committee Meeting – 11.4.24 Discussion regarding the Rectory took place and it was thought that Scrutiny should make the obligation of parishioners to fund the accommodation part of the conversation at the Public Hearing on the 11th April 2024. MK will draft a letter putting forward the Douzeniers concerns above.</p> <p>Church Tower KF wanted to bring to the attention of the meeting the work needed on the Church Tower and how this work could be funded, possibly from congregational donations, fund raising events or other capital sources. Discussion took place but no course of action was recommended.</p> <p>Parish Working Group – SW At the recent Parish Working Group meeting it was noted that there was a new emergency planning law and St Saviours Douzaine were asked if they would be willing to help should a humanitarian disaster occur. There were various scenarios put forward and it was agreed that the Douzaine would support this in any way they could.</p> <p>Waste Requete - SW This was brought up again and the meeting agreed that SW would write to confirm that the Parish was against the new alternative method of dealing with food waste.</p>	MK
